HOLY CROSS CEMETERY is located at 4955 Evergreen Way, Washougal, Washington 98671. It is at the junction of Sunset View Road and Evergreen Highway in Clark County.

On May 9, 1900, Anton and Barbara Gresz donated approximately 1.7 acres to the Diocese of Nesqually for the creation of a new church and cemetery. Holy Cross Cemetery was also known as the Washougal Catholic Cemetery.

The Catholic cemetery is the final resting place for the members of our Faith Community on our Journey to God. It is the gate of heaven. Burial in the consecrated ground of the Catholic cemetery allows you to share your faith values with future generations of your family. This legacy of faith is your gift to them.

A Catholic funeral is centered on the Eucharist, the remembrance and celebration of the death and resurrection of the Lord. A funeral Mass is seen as the foretaste of the heavenly banquet and has always been integral to the burial of Christians who have "died in the hope of rising again."
